PAME is in working towards establishing a "Community of Practice" (CoP) to support the ongoing work on Ecosystem Approach to management (EA) for the Arctic marine environment. The aim is to create an easy to use platform for experts to communicate and share information.

The joint EA expert group with the participation of Arctic Council working groups working on marine-related activities has identified a need for a mechanism to facilitate exchange of information and experiences gained to support the development of a common and coordinated approach to the implementation of the EA by Arctic states. The joint EA expert group will play an important role in CoP by facilitating exchange of information and provide guidance to contribute to a common approach among Arctic Council member states.

COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE (CoP)

A CoP is a group of people who share the same interest. In this case the interest is EA in the Arctic. The Protection of the Arctic Marine Environment (PAME) established the group to further widen participation from EA experts and others who engage in EA matters.

The purpose of a CoP is to share knowledge and experience to operate tasks more efficiently.

Key CoP participants include members of the joint EA expert group and will be invited to identify relevant participants. The PAME Secretariat provides the administrative function for this community. CoPs consist first and foremost of practitioners; experts who perform the same job or collaborate on a shared task. The Community acts like an in-house professional society, cutting across team and divisional boundaries.




COP IN PAME EA PROJECTS/TASKS


